RISK REDUCTION THROUGH FAMILY THERAPY (RRFT)

A yearlong learning collaborative for clinicians about an evidence-based, integrated approach to treating substance use, high risk behaviors, and trauma symptoms among youth exposed to trauma.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Learn about Risk Reduction through Family Therapy, an evidence-based intervention for youth with trauma and high risk behaviors.
2. Learn how to identify youth who would be appropriate for an RRFT referral.
3. Learn how to successfully link families to RRFT treatment (participating agency referral processes will be shared).
4. Learn ways to help families stay engaged in RRFT and monitor treatment progress.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE: Anyone who works with potentially traumatized youth who exhibit high risk behaviors (e.g., substance abuse, self-harm, risky sexual behaviors) and is in the position to help link them to appropriate mental health services. This includes case managers, DCF PIs, Full case managers, victim advocates, referral specialists, etc.

COST: There is no cost to participate in the training. Interested professionals must register in the link provided above.

THE C-START PROJECT: C-START utilizes a learning collaborative approach to engage multiple stakeholders to ensure that children receive appropriate screening, referral to services, and quality treatment.

Kristi House launched C-START in 2012 to build community-wide capacity to deliver evidence-based, trauma-informed, culturally competent treatment interventions for child victims of sexual and other types of trauma.
