What Every Adult Needs to Know

This presentation is especially designed for parents as well as adults working in child-serving organizations who would like to be better equipped to prevent child sexual abuse. The class covers signs and symptoms, provides an understanding of the dynamics of sexual abuse—particularly the manipulative behavior of perpetrators—and offers techniques to support open communication with children to prevent victimization.

Children with Problematic Sexual Behavior

Both boys and girls might display sexual behavior problems without sexual abuse victimization being the underlying cause. Recognizing sexual behavior problems versus normal sexual development is important, as is knowing how to respond. Research suggests about a third of child sexual abuse involves children acting out on other children, with the behavior impelled by exposure to pornography, domestic violence, and other inappropriate sexualized situations.

Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC 101)

This workshop provides a basic overview of commercial sexual exploitation of children (CSEC), the extent of the problem and the impact this type of trauma has on children. It also includes tips for identifying and engaging victims of child sex trafficking, and discussion of services needed for healing and reintegration into mainstream society. It is a Florida DCF-approved training for those working with trafficking victims.

Training certificates are issued to attendees upon completion of a pre- and post-survey.

Children and Traumatic Stress

Child traumatic stress refers to the physical and emotional responses of a child to events that threaten the life of the child or of someone critically important to the child. Social workers, teachers, counselors and others who work with children are invited to participate in this informative program to gain an understanding of traumatic events and their impact on a child's behavior, demeanor and long-term well-being.

Hurricanes: Supporting Families through Trauma

Preparation is key to trauma prevention. This training provides guidance on how families can better prepare for and respond to hurricanes and the threat of hurricanes by identifying key factors that can promote readiness and resilience for children exposed to tropical weather threats before, during and after the storm.

Supporting Families through COVID-19&Other Crises

Times of crises and community upheaval—like what we have experienced in the past year—can have a traumatic impact on children. This presentation provides strategies and tools for mitigating children's anxiety, fears and despair that often accompany times of turmoil.

Human Trafficking and Exploitation of Men and Boys

This workshop, offered in partnership with Ark of Freedom Alliance, helps participants develop strategies to engage with male victims of human trafficking. Attendees will gain a broader knowledge of cultural-specific vulnerabilities that place boys and young men at greater risk for sex and labor trafficking, and ways to improve identification and treatment.
