What Every Adult Needs to Know (CEs)

Designed for parents and adults who would like to be better equipped to prevent child sexual abuse, this class covers signs and symptoms, provides an understanding of the dynamics of sexual abuse—particularly the manipulative behavior of perpetrators—and offers techniques to support open communication with children to prevent victimization.

Children with Problematic Sexual Behavior (CEs)

Both boys and girls might display sexual behavior problems without sexual abuse victimization being the underlying cause. Learn how to recognize sexual behavior problems versus normal sexual development and how to respond.

Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CEs)

This workshop provides a basic overview of commercial sexual exploitation of children (CSEC), the extent of the problem, and the impact this type of trauma has on children. Also learn tips for identifying and engaging victims of child sex trafficking, and discussion of services needed for healing and reintegration into mainstream society. This is a Florida DCF-approved training for those working with trafficking victims.

Children and Traumatic Stress (CEs)

Social workers, teachers, counselors, and others who work with children are invited to participate in this informative program to gain an understanding of traumatic events and their impact on a child's behavior, demeanor, and long-term well-being.

Attendees are provided an electronic certificate upon completion of a pre- and post-survey.

How Mass Violence Impacts Youth

Learn what experts recommend on how to best respond and how to support youth during the aftermath of mass violence, specifically gun violence. This class will provide tools to recognize and respond to mass violence situations, learn about prevention, and understand how community resilience plays a major role in healing trauma.

Suicide Prevention: Question, Persuade, Refer (QPR)

This workshop is designed to empower individuals as gatekeepers in suicide prevention. The primary goal of the workshop was to provide participants with practical skills and knowledge to identify signs of suicidal ideation, engage with individuals at risk, and connect them to appropriate resources.

Stewards of Children® (CEs)

from Darkness to Light

Learn how to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. This nationally recognized, best practice program uses videos, workbook activities and discussion to engage and educate about child sexual abuse and how to keep children safe. Adults learn that child sexual abuse knows no socioeconomic, cultural, or racial boundaries.
